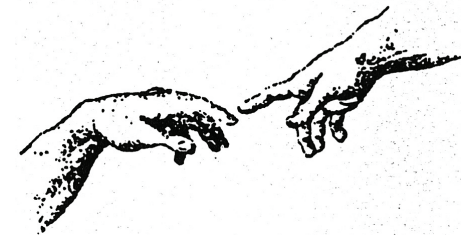

Dr. Bill Gallagher, DC is among the last chiropractors to have studied Directional Non-Force Technique, DNFT™, with Dr. Richard Van Rumpt, the technique's founder.

Having experienced his first DNFT adjustments from Dr. Van Rumpt as he was starting chiropractic college, Dr. Gallagher knew that this was the best way to be adjusted and the only way that he would be able to adjust his own patients.



He started studying the technique in 1983 in addition to his studies at chiropractic school. The extra work paid off. While still an intern in the college public clinic he was the first student to be listed on the DNFT referral list. His clinical proficiency also earned him the position of Intern Supervisor at the college clinic where he was responsible for assisting interns in developing their clinical skills and improving their doctor patient relationships.

Upon graduating from Life Chiropractic College West, cum laude, in 1988 he went into private practice and quickly developed a reputation of being able to help people who had previously not been satisfied with other chiropractic techniques. His patients often drive up to two hours to experience his special type of chiropractic adjustment. The practice has grown on

referrals from satisfied patients to the point that he has now seen patients from at least 20 different countries.



Having started chiropractic college at age 33, Dr. Gallagher brought into his practice a level of life experience and insight that has helped him to better understand his patients as people. The experience has also made it easier to help patients appreciate the process of how they got sick and how they can heal.

His previous work experience includes teaching and coaching from pre-school through adult education along with drug abuse prevention work. He has also worked for major corporations and owned his own businesses.



His own inquisitive nature has also been an asset in his practice. Each new difficult case has challenged him to dig a little deeper to discover the particular cause of the problem and to find a new way to correct it.

His research and the discoveries that they have led to, have been incorporated into the technique and are now taught at DNFT seminars around the world.

Those discoveries include findings that have led to improvements in the correction of problems involving all levels of the spine as well as all the joints of the arms and legs.



Often patients who had resigned themselves to a lifetime of pain and suffering have been able to resume full time work and an active lifestyle following care with Dr. Gallagher.

Likewise, many patients who have had to rely on prescription medications to support their diminished health have been able to reduce or even eliminate those drugs.
